PIANGO Relies on Membership Strength

The effectiveness of the Pacific Islands Association of Non – Government Organisations (PIANGO) depends on its membership strength, emphasised the Executive Director of PIANGO, Cema Bolabola at the PIANGO 3rd National Liaison Unit (NLU) Planning, Implementing, Monitoring, Evaluation and Reporting (PIMER) Consultation.

“PIANGO is only as strong because of your organisations. The stronger the NLU the more effective the interaction with Governments.” she said in her opening remarks at the three day consultation currently held at the Pacific Islands Forum Secretariat (PIFS).

The 3rd NLU PIMER consultation attracted 14 National Umbrella NGOs Directors to discuss issues affecting NGOs as well as to provide information, resources and tools for NLUs and subsequently the national NGO sector.

Moreover, the consultation provides an opportunity for NLUs to learn and share from colleagues from around the region.

In launching the consultation, the PIANGO Executive Director challenged the NLU Directors on issues of NGO resources, PIANGO ownership and project accountability.
